Nature-Based Solutions *Draft* Definition

- Projects that preserve, enhance/recreate or mimic natural ecosystems or processes to provide a range of benefits to both people & the environment
- Address a range of issues including public health & safety, property damages & impaired water quality associated with floods, droughts & heat waves
- Can provide important habitat services, carbon sequestration & improved air quality
